Senior School Uniform Policy

Agreed by Board of Governors: June 2015

KEY STAGE 4

Compulsory Items:

Blazer: navy with senior school badge.
Skirt: navy, knee length, A-line; **no short tight lycra skirts** will be accepted.
Shirt: white
Tie: school colours
Pullover: navy, V-neck with school colours/navy V-neck cardigan
Tights (navy or black opaque at least 40 denier)
Shoes: black, low heel.
(NO TRAINERS OR BLACK PLIMSOLES) Shoes should have black laces and only black stitching.

Optional Items:

Scarf: school colours

KEY STAGE 5 (Sixth Form)

Compulsory Items:

Blazer: navy with senior school badge.
Skirt: grey, knee length, A-line
Shirt: white
Tie: with school colours **(if prefect tie can be bought from school)**
Cardigan: grey V-neck – regulation grey
Tights: black cotton, opaque (at least 40 denier)
Shoes: black, low heel.
(NO TRAINERS OR BLACK PLIMSOLES) Shoes should have black laces and only black stitching.

KEY STAGE 4 AND KEY STAGE 5 (Sixth Form)

For very specific reasons (e.g. medical, supported by evidence from a Health Professional) and only with the permission of the Principal (or V.P in his absence) students may be permitted to wear smart, business style trousers to school. Parents should make a written request to the Principal via the main office.

Jewellery:

Pupils may wear the following items of jewellery **only**:

One watch

One pair stud earrings in the lower ear lobe

One small ring

One pair small stud earrings in the lower ear lobe

Students are NOT permitted to wear any other upper ear lobe or facial (including tongue) piercings and will be expected to remove them if they are worn in school. If a student refuses to remove a facial piercing, work will be provided and she may be sent home until such time as she removes the piercing.

School Bag:

An appropriate school bag **must** be carried daily. School bags **must not** display political emblems or football team colours/emblems.

Correct equipment for use in lessons should be in the school bag. As a minimum list, this includes a pen, pencil, ruler, some coloured pencils and a calculator.

Physical Education:

KS4 EXAMINATION PE CLASSES

Navy GCSE PE School Polo Shirt with school crest (may be purchased from PE Department in September)

Navy School Tracksuit bottoms with school crest (may be purchased from “The Sport’s Company” at Yorkgate)

KS4 CORE PE CLASSES

Any appropriate sportswear e.g. Tracksuit, Sweatshirt or T-Shirt with tracksuit bottoms etc., trainers, Football shirts and shorts are not permitted.

PIN BADGES/RIBBONS (CHARITY):

Students are permitted to wear one charity pin badge or ribbon on the lapel of their blazer. (e.g. breast cancer awareness, British Legion Poppy Appeal). These badges or ribbons must not display political emblems or football team colours/emblems.

Hair

Students are only permitted to have natural hair colour. Bright or extreme coloured dyes are not acceptable.

Students may wear a simple plain band or a bobble to tie back their hair.

Make-Up

- Make up in Years 11 to 14 should be kept to a minimum
- No coloured nail varnish
