

## YEAR 12 HOME-SCHOOL STUDY PROGRAME 2018



This document is your guide to the arrangements for home-school study prior to your Public Examinations. There will be 3 phases to your home-school study programme;

**Phase 1 is school based and will begin on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May** when Core PE, Core RS, LLW and Careers will become supervised study sessions rather than taught classes. All other timetabled lessons continue as normal. This is the equivalent of 3½ hours per week of supervised study.

Phase 2 is also school based and will begin on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May. During this phase, special revision sessions will be timetabled to support you prior to specific examinations that begin this week. <u>These revision sessions are compulsory</u> and take priority over normal timetabled lessons. Unless you are in an exam or attending a special revision session, you follow your normal timetable in full.

**Phase 3 combines home and school study and will begin on Mon 4<sup>th</sup> June**. During this phase formal examinations and special revision classes continue to be timetabled and <u>attendance at these is compulsory</u> for all pupils. With parental permission you may study at home during this phase. You will however be expected to attend school;

- $\circ$   $\;$  To attend special revision classes prior to examinations.
- $\circ$   $\;$  To sit your remaining formal examinations.
- If you are on home-school study, you should come to school through the MAIN ENTRANCE. There is no need to sign in as your teachers will **take registers** at every session.
- There will be no form registration during phase 3. If timetabled for a Period 1 lesson or revision session you should arrive in time for Period 1 at 9.00am. You are of course welcome in school and can revise in the Dining Centre if you arrive early.
- YOU SHOULD GO TO THE TEACHING ROOM INDICATED ON YOUR TIMETABLE FOR YOUR REVISION SESSION.

You will only be able to take part in this programme if you have your reply slip signed by a parent/carer and return it to school. If you do not do this or your parent/carer says that you cannot study at home from Mon 4<sup>th</sup> June, you will be expected in school as normal, until the end of term 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018.
