GCSE Results 2020

I am delighted to inform you that Year 12 students may come to school on **Thursday 20th August 2020** between **9.30am - 11.00am**, to collect their GCSE/L2 equivalent external examination results.

In accordance with COVID-19 protocols, students will however, not be able to enter the school building and strict social distancing measures will be in place.

With this in mind, students will be able to collect their results from the entrance to the school building where they will be met by school staff.

If a Year 12 student meets the entry requirements and wishes to return to study at Post 16, at the Belfast Model School for Girls, she must telephone the school office before Midday on Friday 21st August to register her interest.

Following this, students should complete and retain the application form within the Post 16 Learning Pathways Student's Choice Booklet, in preparation for a telephone interview with a member of school staff, week beginning Monday 24th August 2020.
