This year all students will receive all external examination results by post on Thursday August 13th 2020.

Students who are awaiting results from the CCEA examination board can also access their results online using a personalised identification number (PIN) from 8.00am on Thursday August 13th 2020. Your personalised identification number (PIN) can be found on the enclosed letter. Results from all other examination boards are not available online, but will be posted out to students.

As you await your results, can I ask you to remember that the most important thing is that you are able you progress to the next phase in your career and educational journey, that is Year 14 A2 or equivalent courses.

All Year 13 students wishing to progress to Year 14 A2 or equivalent courses must have obtained AS/equivalent results which would provide a sufficient foundation for further study.
