1

There are no public examinations

2

Teachers will use their professional judgement to decide grades. *(We are supporting this work with training, support materials and guidance)*

3

Evidence can take multiple forms e.g. coursework, previous class assessment, CCEA's **optional** assessment resources and/or classwork

4

The CCEA assessment resources are **optional** *(These will be marked by teachers)*

5

Students will only be **assessed** on what they have **been taught**

6

Centre Determined Grades will be based on a student's work

7

Work **completed at home** can contribute to the evidence

8

Schools will let students know what evidence is being used

9

The **full range of grades**, including A\*, will continue to be awarded for GCSE and A level

10

There is **flexibility** for schools as everyone will have had a different learning experience
