Dear Parent/Guardian

Year 11 students are to return to school at 8.45am on Friday 27th August for the first day of their Induction Programme. As your daughter is entering Year 1 of Key Stage 4, a Teambuilding event has been organised to help students form positive relationships, as well as promote key skills and attitudes for learning and achieving in the months ahead.

Your daughter should arrive in full PE uniform, ready to participate. Please note that Converse shoes and denim jackets are NOT to be worn. In line with government and DE guidance, a face covering should be worn, unless exempt.

Your daughter will enter the building via the underpass at Point G and will go directly to her form room. Enclosed with this letter is a map to help give your daughter an indication of where she should access from this date, however, please be assured staff will be at hand to assist in directing students to the correct area.

The Teambuilding session will finish at 11.55am. Please note that lunch will not be available and school buses will not be operational on this day. Students should bring a snack with them for break.

The second day of Induction for Year 11 will take place on Thursday 2nd September. You are warmly invited to accompany your daughter to school and attend a brief assembly, led by the Principal, Ms Stuart and your daughter's Leader of Learning, Mrs Graham. (Refreshments will be served). Please enter through the main school doors and in accordance with government guidelines, it is important you wear a face covering, unless exempt. You are free to leave after the assembly but students will remain in school until 12.35pm.

Although your daughter is familiar with school and routines we want to take this opportunity to meet with the Principal as well as inform you of any changes. We would like to begin this year working in close partnership with you.

Please note that a 'Grab and Go' lunch will be available on this day and school buses will be operational in the morning and afternoon. Students should bring a snack with them for break.

We are really looking forward to seeing your daughter again on Friday 27th August. In the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact school should you need to.
