There will be an important Parents' Consultation meeting for Year 10 students on Friday 6 January from 11.55am-2.25pm. This meeting is a valuable opportunity to meet with your child's subject teachers to discuss their progress and to also identify the best ways to support their learning.

There will be a presentation to parents at 11.55am in the hall before the meetings begin, to give some key information, particularly in relation to the months ahead.

It is very important that your child is represented; if you cannot attend it is acceptable to send a representative on your behalf. Your child should accompany you but uniform is not required.

To help focus conversations with teachers, the following questions may be helpful. These will be available on each desk on the day.

In this subject

- What are the results of assessments my child completed in Term 1?
- What specifically does my child have to do to ensure that she reaches her target % in future assessments?
- Does my child demonstrate positive behaviours for learning?
 - o If no, what is a focus for improvement?
 - o If yes, what positive behaviours should we continue to encourage?
 - What level of effort does my child put into her work into class/homework tasks?
- Does my child have the capacity to successfully study this subject at GCSE/L2 level?
- What Career pathway choices does this subject choice support?
 - Are there any career pathways for which this subject choice is compulsory?
- What can I do as a Parent to further support my child in their learning?
