Dear Parent/Guardian,

There will be an important Parents' Consultation meeting for Year 11 students on Friday 6 January 2023 from 9.00am -11.15am. This meeting is a valuable opportunity to meet with your child's subject teachers to discuss their progress and to also identify the best ways to support their learning.

There will be a presentation to parents at 9.00am in the hall before the meetings begin, to give some key information, particularly in relation to the months ahead.

It is very important that your child is represented; if you cannot attend it is acceptable to send a representative on your behalf. Your child should accompany you but uniform is not required.

To help focus conversations with teachers, the following questions may be helpful. These will be available on each desk on the day.

For each subject:

- What GCSE/L2 grade is my child currently working at?
  O What assessments/coursework is this based upon?
- What is my child's predicted GCSE/L2 grade?
- What specifically does my child have to do to ensure that she reaches her GCSE/L2 predicted grade?
- What topics must my child prepare to perform well in this term's GCSE/L2 PPE (Pre-Public Examination)?
- Does my child demonstrate positive behaviours for learning?
  - If not, what is a focus for improvement?
  - If yes, what positive behaviours should we continue to encourage?
  - What level of effort does my child put into her work into class/homework tasks?
- What can I do as a Parent to further support my child in their learning?
