You are invited to attend the Year 13 Parents' Consultation meeting on Thursday 5th January from 12.30pm-3.30pm.

This meeting is a valuable opportunity to meet with your child's subject teachers to discuss their progress in their chosen GCE/L3 subjects, and to identify the best ways to further support their learning at this key point in the academic year.

There will be a presentation to parents at 12.30pm in the hall before the teacher meetings begin, to provide some key information, particularly in relation to the months ahead in the lead up to the 2023 GCE/L3 examination series.

It is very important that your child is represented; if you cannot attend it is acceptable to send a representative on your behalf. Year 13 students should also attend the Parents' Consultation meeting; however uniform is not required.

Please find below some suggested questions that will help to provide a framework for discussion during the meetings with your child's subject teachers:

- What AS/L3 grade is my child currently working at?
- What assessments/coursework is this AS/L3 based upon?
- What is my child's predicted AS/L3 grade?
- What specifically does my child have to do to ensure that she reaches her predicted AS/L3 grade?
- What topics must my child prepare, to perform well in this term's AS/L3 PPE (Pre-Public Examination)?
- What study skills does my child need to develop to be more independent in her learning at Post 16?
- What can I do as a Parent to further support my child in their learning?
