- Calm with Carole is a counselling and training specialist service.
- A team of counsellors using play, Lego and other creative methods to engage children and young people in their growth and journey towards understanding themselves better.
- CALM provides 1-1 and group sessions and also work with families and young people disengaged with education.
- CALM offers children and young people a space to talk about their thoughts and feelings in a safe environment, helping them to share any worries or problems they may have and to build their confidence and self-esteem.
- CALM is an inclusive intervention that offers specialised approaches unique to each child's needs.





Carol Chisim Teacher at BMSG

- Before GCSEs were invented, students took exams called O and A-Levels. At Belfast Model School for Girls students had to study English Language, English Literature, Maths and French. Carol chose Geography, Physics, Art and Additional Maths as options and continued with Geography, English Literature and Maths and a Use of English/Qualification for A-Level.
- Studied at Queen's University Belfast and qualified with an honours degree in Geography, followed by a Postgraduate Certificate in Education, therefore qualifying as a Geography and Mathematics teacher.
- Returned to BMSG as a supply teacher in 1990 and became permanent in 2000, as a Geography teacher.
- Became Head of Geography and also held additional roles including editor of the school publications, staff trainer in ICT applications and assistant pastoral lead in Post 16 and at Key Stage 3.
