

Heidi Lyttle Primary School: Glenwood PS


The night before my first day as a Girls' Model student I felt excited about new subjects, new after-school clubs, making new friends and the chance to meet my new teachers.

Primary School: Wheatfield PS



Before starting 'big school' I was very nervous and didn't know what to expect, but I was also very excited to meet new friends.


I've really enjoyed my first term and liked all the teachers and meeting new people from different form classes.

Leona Smyth Primary School: Bally Sillan PS



The night before my first day of school I got ready and laid all my stuff out so I wouldn't be late, I found it difficult to sleep as I couldn't wait for school the next day.


My first term has been good. I have made lots of friends and I have nice teachers. The only thing I don't like is having to get up in the morning!

I felt quite nervous before starting and I couldn't really sleep the night before my first day as I was nervous but also excited for a fresh start.


My mummy drove me there and I was met by older students who showed me where to go. I was put into a form class with a few of my friends.

On my first day I met my form teacher and my new class. They were all very nice and funny.


My first term has been very fun and filled with laughter!


