## **COMPULSORY ITEMS:**

### **School Uniform**

#### **Blazer:**

- **Years 8 – 12:** Navy blazer with school badge
- **Years 13-14:** Burgundy blazer with school badge

#### **Skirt:**

- **Years 8-14:** Grey, ankle length, pleated
- *No other skirts will be accepted*

#### **Shirt:**

- White (long or short sleeved)

#### **Jumper:**

- **Years 8 – 12:** Navy V-neck with school colours
- **Years 13 – 14:** Grey V-neck with school badge

#### **Cardigan:**

- **Years 11 - 12 only:** Navy cardigan with school
- **Years 13 - 14 only:** Grey cardigan with school badge

#### **Tights/Socks:**

- Black

#### **Tie:**

- **Year 8 – 12:** Navy background with red and yellow stripes
- **Year 13 – 14:** navy background with school crest

### **Shoes:**

Shoes must be formal, black, and flat or low-heeled.

The following are **not permitted**:

- No coloured laces other than black
- No white soles
- No suede / canvas
- No plimsolls
- No trainers, Converse, Vans etc
- No ballet style shoes / pumps
- No boots
- No Crocs

### **School Bag**

- A suitable school bag **must** be carried every day
- The bag must be large enough to safely carry **A4-sized books and folders**
- School bags **must not** display political emblems or football team colours/emblems
- Must contain essential equipment, including:
  - Pen
  - Pencil
  - Ruler
  - Coloured pencils
  - Calculator
  - School planner

### **Physical Education**

- Red school polo shirt and/or red/black school t-shirt (with crest)
- Red school hoodie and/or black ¼ zip top (with crest)
- Black school sports leggings and/or black tracksuit bottoms (with BMSG branding)
- White trainer/ankle socks

### **Trainers:**

- Must be suitable for sport
- *Vans, Converse, and fashion trainers are **NOT permitted***

### **OPTIONAL ITEMS:**

#### **Summer Blouse:**

- May be worn May to September

#### **Physical Education:**

- Black School Shorts **and/or** Skort – with school crest
- Black School Gilet

#### **Coat:**

- An appropriate coat may be worn to and from school but must be removed once in the school building. They can be placed in a school bag or left with a member of staff.

#### **Scarf:**

- School scarf available

### **Jewellery:**

For reasons of health and safety, students are permitted to wear limited jewellery in school.

The following items are permitted:

- One wristwatch
- One small ring
- Small stud or small hoop earrings
- Small nose stud(s)  
(Nose rings are not permitted)

No other jewellery or **visible body or facial piercings** are permitted.

Where jewellery is worn that does not meet these expectations, students will be required to remove the item(s) to ensure they remain safe for learning. Decisions on whether jewellery meets these expectations or not is at the discretion of the Senior Leadership Team and the Principal.

If a student refuses to comply with this requirement, appropriate work will be provided and the student will be supervised in our learning hub until the issue is resolved and the student is able to remain to classes.

### **Pin badges/ribbons (charity):**

Students are permitted to wear charity pin badges or ribbons on the lapel of their blazer. (e.g. breast cancer awareness, British Legion Poppy Appeal). These badges or ribbons must not display political emblems or football team colours/emblems.

### **Hair:**

There is a strong preference that hair is coloured in a natural colour. Students may wear a simple plain band or a bobble to tie back their hair.

### **Make-Up:**

No make-up for Years 8-10

Make up in Years 11-14 should be kept to a minimum and be subtle

### **Nails:**

*For reasons promoting the Health and Safety of all, students are **NOT** permitted to have long or pointed nails or nail extensions. Students may have their nails painted.*

**NB:** A supply of spare uniform is kept in the Student Hub. Students who are wearing incorrect items of uniform will be expected to wear these on a temporary basis.

# SCHOOL UNIFORM

Simple plain hair band or bobble

Small stud or small hoop earrings

Small nose stud(s)  
No other jewellery or visible body or facial piercings are permitted

Shirt: white

Tie: School colours, navy background with red and yellow stripes

Blazer: Navy with school badge, to be worn every day

Jumper: Navy, 'V' neck with school colours (Years 8-12)

One small ring

A watch

Skirt: Grey; ankle length, pleated

Tights: Black, opaque at least 60 denier

Shoes: Black flat shoes with black laces and only black stitching
